1 Conference Venue

The conference will take place in the Felix-Klein-Hörsaal on the fifth floor of the **Paulinum** which is a section of the new main building of the University at the Augustusplatz. See for example

You can enter this new building (whose photo you find on the conference announcement) from Augustusplatz. It is a 10 minute walk from the central/main railway station (*Hauptbahnhof*) and from the Novotel hotel, the Motel One and the Days Inn Hotel.

2 Arriving in Leipzig

2.1 Arriving at Leipzig/Halle Airport

Deutsche Bahn InterCity (IC) and RegionalExpress (RE) trains run regularly between Leipzig airport and Hauptbahnhof Leipzig (Leipzig central/main railway station) and take 15 minutes. Tickets are available at vending machines at the platforms.

Please note that for IC trains you have to pay an extra fee so that they are more expensive - about $6 \in$ the RE trains cost about $4 \in$.

There are also various taxi services which offer airport shuttles. A ride to the city center will cost between 25 and 30 \in .

If you arrive at a different airport (Berlin, Frankfurt,...) you can take a train to Leipzig Hauptbahnhof (Leipzig central/main railway station).

Hauptbahnhof Leipzig (Leipzig central/main railway station) is located right in the city centre. The conference venue can be reached within 10 minutes walk.
